Experience traditional performing art Kabuki

Hikiyama Gallery MIYOSSA is the iconic facility for Kabuki in Komatsu. 'MIYOSSA' means 'let's try' in the Komatsu regional dialect. There are many hands-on traditional activities to enjoy.

Mizuhiki Experience

(Decorative Japanese cord made from twisted paper)

Learn the basic skills needed to make Mizuhiki, and take home with you as a wonderful memory.

Kabuki Make-up & Photo

In this popular program, learn the tricks of Kabuki make-up, and transform yourself into a Kabuki actor. We recommend taking a photo posing in front of the Hikiyama float.

Play the Shamisen

The instrument used in Kabuki is the shamisen. Simple songs can soon be mastered even by beginners. Other Japanese musical instruments used in Kabuki performances are also available for use.

Dance Performance

Dance on the Kabuki stage and learn the regional style of dance. Experience the challenge of dancing using a Japanese fan.

Historically, Komatsu culture was greatly influenced by Toshitune Maeda, Lord of Kaga Domain in the Edo Period. A great admirer of the fine arts, tea ceremony and Noh, he helped establishing many local industries by inviting experts and master craftsmen to build shrines and temples, resulting in a flourishing of culture, art and industry in the region. Komatsu is a world famous producer of construction machinery. At Komatsu-no-Mori, see and get on the 930E, one of the world's largest dump trucks.

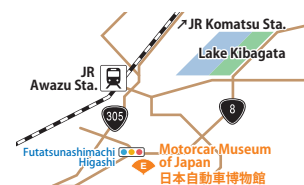
